Points to Ponder

GET OFF OF THE ROLLERCOASTER

In an age marked by global instability, economic stress, relentless negative news, and deep social division, many Christians struggle with anxiety and emotional turmoil. Social media often reflects this tension, with people declaring "God is good" one moment and expressing despair or anger the next. Anxiety disorders affect millions of Americans, and while professional mental health treatment is a valuable blessing, Christians can also cultivate spiritual habits to strengthen emotional well-being.

First, make everything a matter of prayer. Philippians 4:6 says, (v. 6) *Don't worry about anything; instead, pray about everything. Tell God what you need ...*

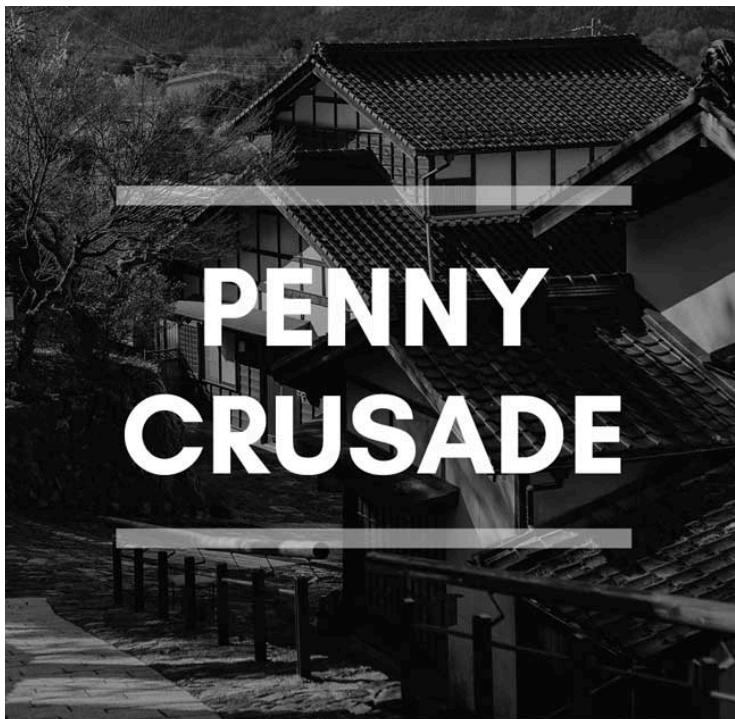
As believers, we are urged to replace worry with prayer, bringing every concern to God. Studies show that the vast majority of things we worry about never materialize or cannot be changed. Prayer not only invites God to act but also transforms the one who prays, filling the heart with divine peace.

Second, develop perspective through gratitude. Paul instructs believers to pray "with thanksgiving." Regularly reflecting on blessings shifts focus from problems to God's goodness. Gratitude widens our view and counters the nearsightedness that magnifies difficulties.

Third, redirect your thoughts. Philippians 4:8 commands believers to dwell *on what is true, noble, pure, and praiseworthy*. Since thoughts shape emotions, disciplining the mind leads to emotional stability.

By practicing prayer, gratitude, and intentional thinking, Christians can experience God's peace guarding their hearts and minds.

WHAT IS PENNY CRUSADE

In 1956, Chester Randall made an unusual donation of 4,175 pennies to help Advent Christians spread the gospel to the nations. This served as an inspiration and launch pad for a yearly denominational fundraising effort called Penny Crusade. Since then, more than 20 million dollars has been raised and sent by more than 300 AC churches.

WHERE DOES THE MONEY GO

Advent Christian ministry partnerships now exist in 19 countries. Indian pastors, Filipino missionaries, African pastors, children's homes, a Bible college, discipleship groups, feeding ministries, training events and new church plants are all strengthened by money raised through Penny Crusade. One hundred percent of Penny Crusade dollars goes to missions. (See the back of this card).

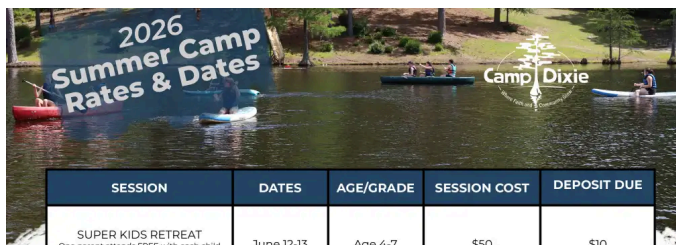
